

**The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable
Pressure Equipment Regulations 2009**

**Authorisation No 150
Applicable to Carriage by Road**

This authorisation is given in accordance with Regulation 12 (1) of the Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations 2009 (The Carriage Regulations)

PURPOSE

To allow the Carriage of UN 0143 NITROGLYCERIN, DESENSITISED with not less than 40% non-volatile, water-insoluble phlegmatizer, by mass with alternative packaging, marking and labelling

TIME LIMIT

This authorisation comes into effect on 1 January 2010 and remains valid until 31 May 2011

ALTERNATIVE CARRIAGE PROVISIONS

- 1 The authorisation shall apply to the carriage by road within Great Britain between the port of entry and a factory for processing.
- 2 The desensitised nitroglycerine may be packaged, marked and labelled in accordance with the requirements for UN 3319 NITROGLYCERIN MIXTURE, DESENSITIZED, SOLID, N.O.S. with more than 2% but not more than 10% nitroglycerine by mass.
- 3 No other dangerous goods should be carried on the vehicle
- 4 A copy of this authorisation shall be attached to the transport documentation for each shipment.
- 5 All other relevant provisions of the Carriage Regulations in relation to the carriage of HD 1.1D explosives shall be complied with.
