

# The Future Development of Air Transport in the UK: Scotland

## GLASGOW AIRPORT EXHIBITION

A Government consultation is underway to examine how air services and airports should develop over the next 30 years. This includes options for expanding Glasgow Airport.

As part of the consultation process you are invited to visit the Glasgow Airport Exhibition.

You will be able to view maps of the options and presentations summarising the appraisal of those options, pick up relevant documentation and find out how you can take part in the consultation. Department for Transport, Scottish Executive and Scotland Office staff and their consultants will be present to provide advice and answer questions.

**The exhibition will be open from 8.00 a.m. – 8.00 p.m. on 8th October in the Braehead Arena Foyer of the Braehead Shopping Centre, Kings Inch Road, Glasgow G51 4BN**

There is free parking at the shopping centre and the foyer is accessible from the lift in the Blue Car Park. Disabled parking is available at the centre. The nearest railway station is Paisley Gilmour Street, which is 2 miles from the centre. By bus, there are frequent services to Glasgow City Centre operated by Scottish Citylink & Fairline Coaches with drop off points at various locations within the city, including Glasgow Central, Queen Street railway stations & Buchanan Bus Station. By road Braehead is located between Glasgow International Airport and the City Centre off Junction 26 of the M8 Motorway, local access is provided through the A8 Glasgow/Renfrew road and the A736 Hillington.
