

Under the DEOM scheme a vehicle may be licensed at first registration for part of the month plus the normal 6 or 12 months. The scheme is voluntary and is open to all vehicles in duty paying taxation classes. Licences are only available from a DVLA local office or from dealers participating in the Automated First Registration and Licensing (AFRL) scheme. There are three start dates available: 10th, 17th and 24th day of each month. The normal rate of duty is payable plus an additional supplement (rates are listed overleaf). Standard licence discs are issued and show the additional weeks plus total duty paid e.g. duty + supplement.

A Your questions

- **Is this method of licensing compulsory?**
No. DEOM licences are only issued on request. The scheme is a supplement to the existing system.
- **What is meant by first registration?**
The registration and licensing of a vehicle in the United Kingdom for the first time.
A vehicle which is registered under this system cannot, if it is permanently imported into the other country, have a DEOM licence when it is being registered again.
- **Does the date of registration have to be the 10th, 17th or 24th?**
No. It can be any date in the month on or after the 10th day as at present, but a DEOM licence will run from the preceding start date e.g. if the date of registration is the 15th, duty is payable from the 10th and the licence will run for 6 or 12 months + 3 weeks.
- **Can an application still be made up to 14 days in advance?**
Yes, except for AFRL applications. The 14-day rule will apply to all start dates. Applications made 14 days in advance will be accepted but the actual licence will not be sent until just before its start date. AFRL applications can only be accepted on the date of first registration.
- **What details need to be completed on form V55 (Application for first licensing and registration)?**
The additional week(s) should be entered in the box after 'Months', at question 3 – Period of Licence applied for. The total duty (duty + supplement) should be shown in the duty payable box 4. Box 26 or 28 should be completed as normal with the date on which the licence is to commence.
Different DEOM supplements will apply depending on the rate of vehicle excise duty payable.

- **Can a DEOM application be made at a Post Office® branch?**
No. Applications must be made through a DVLA local office or an AFRL dealer.
- **What registration mark is appropriate for licences which start on the 10th, 17th or 24th day of the month immediately preceding bi-annual change of year identifier?**
Applications for licensing new vehicles in these circumstances can only be accepted if the V53 slip allocated from the bi-annual series is attached.
- **Is the supplement taken into account when a refund of duty is paid?**
No. Only complete unexpired months will be refunded. No part of the supplement is refundable.

* **NOTE** - A date to end of month first licence is valid for 6 or 12 months plus 1, 2 or 3 weeks and runs from the 10th (3 weeks), 17th (2 weeks) or the 24th (1 week) day of the month. An application for a licence to run from any day between the 1st and 9th of the month should be dealt with in the usual way, and a standard 6 or 12 month licence issued.
