

How to get to DVLA Swansea

The offices of DVLA Swansea are sited near Morryston to the north of the City.

Travel by Train

Visitors arriving by rail should travel to Swansea Station. From the station DVLA Swansea is accessible by either public transport or taxi. Taxis are available outside the main entrance and will cost approximately £7.

Travel by Bus

Buses to DVLA Swansea take roughly 30 minutes and cost approximately £2.60 return. Buses run every 15 minutes. Service number **36**.

The nearest bus stop to the station and DVLA Swansea is shown in the attached plan.

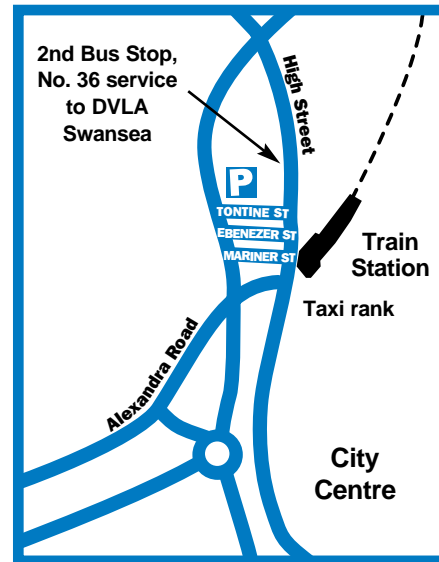
Travel by Car

From London or Midlands

Visitors driving west from London or the Midlands should leave the M4 at **Junction 46**, take the first exit from the roundabout for the **A48** and travel for ½ mile. Entry to the main site is on the right via **Longview Road**.

From West Wales

Visitors driving east from Carmarthen or West Wales should leave the M4 at **Junction 46**, signposted Llangyfelach/Felindre. Take the 3rd exit at the top of slip road. At the next roundabout, take the 1st exit for the **A48**, follow the signs to DVLA (travel for approx. ½ mile). Entry to the main site is via **Longview Road**.



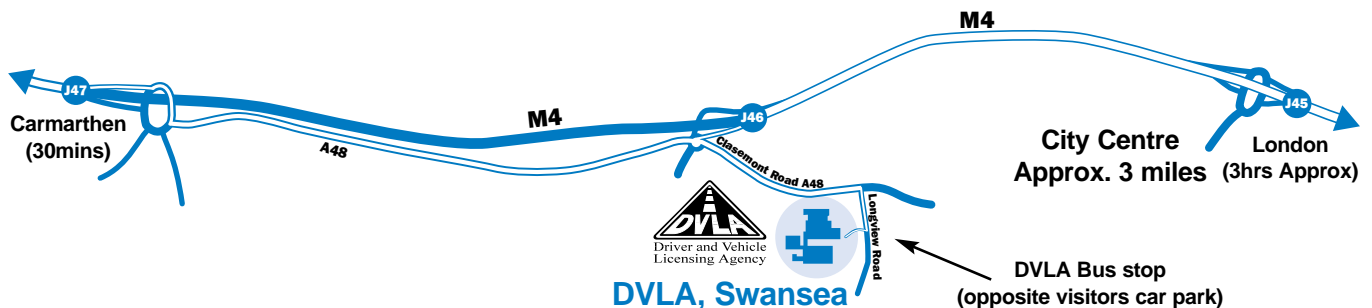
Taxi ranks and bus stop

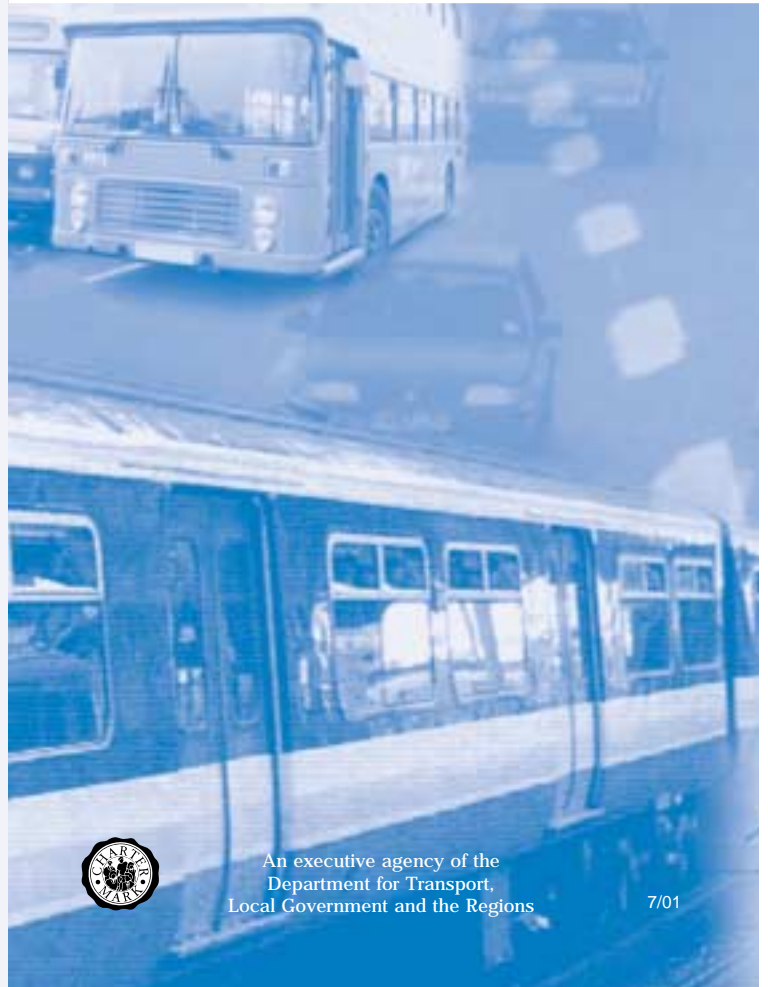
