How do I get Recruitment Plus working for me?

Simply call Remploy Interwork and tell them you are applying for a job through Recruitment Plus, confirm that you are eligible for the service, and follow the six simple steps into work...



Step 1 Call the Recruitment Plus Helpline

Step 2 Applying for the job

- Personal advice on in-work benefits and job grants that may be available
- Help completing the application form
- Help and advice on the 'Guaranteed Interview' Scheme
- Access to training where you need it

Step 3 Interviews

- Support throughout the interview process
- Advice and coaching in interview techniques
- Feedback on your interview

Step 4 If you don't get an interview

- Help you look for another job if you don't meet the essential criteria
- Put together a personal development plan
- Help you gain some work experience

Step 5 Job Offers

- Help with job related issues
- Advice on job grants available through Access To Work etc
- Help to review your job plan, making sure it's right for the job you've been offered

Step 6 Starting your new job

- Monitor your job start plan with your new Manager
- Continue to support you as you take up your new job
- Keep in touch to make sure your job plan is still on track

Your questions answered:

Will I definitely get an interview for a job?

Interwork will do everything possible to help you to prepare for interview, but the employer whose vacancy you are applying for decides who will be selected for interview. This is dependent on a person's skills and suitability for the job. Interviews are not guaranteed for every job applicant.
