## **M-Notices: Pricing and Availability Information**

### **Notice to all recipients of M-Notices**

#### **Summary**

M-Notices publicise important safety, pollution prevention and other relevant information to the maritime industry eg shipping and fishing vessels, commercial yachts and small passenger vessels.

- Current M-Notices are listed on-line at [www.mcga.gov.uk](http://www.mcga.gov.uk) .
- Electronic copies can be accessed and printed from our website free of charge.
- Paper copies are available by subscription from EC Group.

### **1. Types of M-Notice**

- Merchant Shipping Notices (MSNs): explain or form a part of maritime safety regulations.
- Marine Guidance Notes (MGNs): set out important advice, guidance and strong recommendations about best practice.
- Marine Information Notes (MINs): contain less important time-limited information and changes of addresses.

1.1 Notices marked “M” are particularly relevant to merchant shipping and those marked “F” are particularly relevant to fishing vessels.

### **2. Carriage Requirements**

2.1 Regulation 27 of Chapter V of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) requires: *Nautical charts and nautical publications, such as sailing directions, lists of lights, notices to mariners, tide tables and all other nautical publications necessary for the intended voyage, shall be adequate and up to date.* See <http://www.mcga.gov.uk/c4mca/mcga07-home/shipsandcargoes/mcga-shipsregsandguidance/mcga-spubs.htm>

2.2 The carriage of M-Notices forms part of the nautical publications requirement above. M-Notices can be carried in paper or electronic format, provided they are continually accessible to all relevant individuals.
