It includes the Department's plans to support economic growth and to address transport's climate change impacts, responding to the recommendations made in the **Eddington Transport Study** and the **Stern Review of the Economics of Climate Change**; and progress made on the **Towards a Sustainable Transport System (TaSTS)** process so far and next steps.
