



Rail Stations

The Disability Discrimination Act requires all station operators to take reasonable steps to ensure that they do not discriminate against disabled people.

All station operators already provide access to their service. However, what is judged as reasonable provision today may not be in the future and station operators need to keep their provisions under review.

Access for All Stations

Provides information on the stations which are receiving investment with the Access for All funding.

Small Schemes Funding

Accessible station design

All licensed passenger train operators and station operators are required, as a condition of their licence, to have due regard to Train and Station Services for Disabled Passengers.
