

The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations 2004

Authorisation No 47

Applicable to carriage by road

This authorisation is given in accordance with Regulation 36(8) of The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations 2004, as amended (The Carriage Regulations).

PURPOSE

To allow the carriage of UN 0143 NITROGLYCERIN, DESENSITIZED with not less than 40% non-volatile water-insoluble phlegmatizer, by mass with alternative packaging, marking and labelling.

TIME LIMIT

This authorisation comes into effect immediately and remains valid until 1 January 2010.

ALTERNATIVE CARRIAGE PROVISIONS

1. The authorisation shall apply only to the road carriage within Great Britain between the port of entry and a factory for processing.
2. The dangerous goods may be packaged, marked and labelled in accordance with the requirements for UN 3319 'NITROGLYCERIN MIXTURE, DESENSITIZED, SOLID, N.O.S. with more than 2% but not more than 10% nitroglycerin, by mass.
3. All other relevant provisions of the Carriage Regulations in relation to the carriage of 1.1D explosives shall be complied with.
