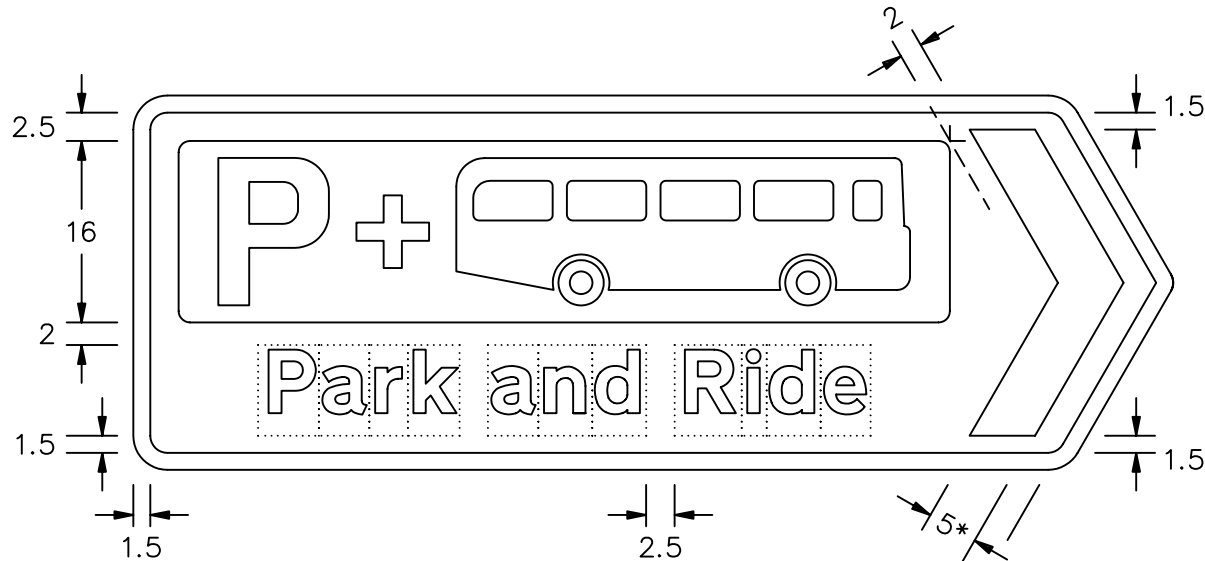

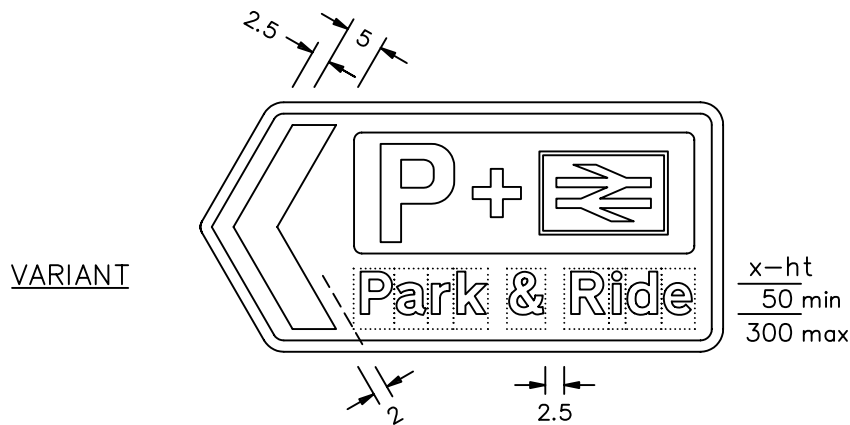

5. DIMENSIONS : x-heights are in millimetres, other dimensions are in stroke widths. (4sw = x-height)
