

ROAD SAFETY GRANT DETERMINATION (2007/08 to 2010/11): No 31/527

The Minister of State for Transport ("the Minister of State"), in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, hereby makes the following determination:-

Citation

1) This determination may be cited as the Road Safety Specific Grant Determination (2007/08 to 2010/11) [No31/527].

Purpose of the grant

2) The purpose of the grant is to provide support to local authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

3) The Minister of State determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the maximum amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and the amounts set out in Annex A.

Treasury consent

4) Before making this determination in relation to local authorities in England, the Minister of State obtained the consent of the Treasury.
