DESIGNATION OF HERITAGE ITEMS AT CREWE WORKS

I refer to our previous communications on this subject. Further to the most useful visit to Crewe Works by members of our Artefacts sub-committee on 5th April, it was proposed at main committee on 26th July that the collection of heritage items listed in your July 1996 Crewe site *Catalogue of Memorabilia* be designated as a whole. This was agreed. It was recognised that clearly some items were of greater significance than others, and that in due course judicious sifting could and should take place. Nonetheless, it was felt that it was important to put down a marker at this point. Herewith a formal Designation Notice, which I would be grateful if you would acknowledge.

Members of both Artefacts and Records Sub-committee will give further consideration to the subject when they meet next on 1st November – by which time perhaps Phil Bateman might have been able to discuss certain individual matters with Dieter Hopkin and others at the National Railway Museum.

Lastly, I would reiterate that there is no suggestion of your giving up any of this material until such time – if ever – you are so minded.

(This note is not part of the Notice)

Notes

The Railway Heritage Committee has the function, under section 3 of the *Railway Heritage Act 1996*, of designating those classes or descriptions of records or artefacts which it considers to be of sufficient interest to warrant preservation.

Care of Designated Records and Artefacts

Owners are expected to take reasonable care in the custody and use of designated records and artefacts.

The designation does not in any way restrict their use, nor prevent amendment or modification.


The Committee would however wish to be advised of any significant changes to an artefact, for two reasons:

1. to ensure a record is kept of the changes;
2. to enable it to consider whether any further designation might be necessary, for example of a key component that could one day be re-united with the original item.

Whilst the Committee may designate records for preservation, such designation does not imply any public right of access unless the owner of the designated item grants such access.

Disposal

Any proposal to dispose of designated items must be notified to the Committee and may not be completed until agreed by the Committee or there has been a lapse of six months from the notification.
