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**CHANGES TO THE MINIMUM FINANCIAL STANDING LEVELS
REQUIRED BY HOLDERS OF HGV AND PSV OPERATORS' LICENCES**

The Department for Transport has given notice of revisions to the minimum levels of financial backing required by holders of goods and PSV operators' licences. This is an EU requirement.

This will affect holders of standard national, standard international and restricted licences. The most significant change is that the holders of standard national licences will now have to meet the same levels of financial standing as standard international licence holders. The original Directive had contained a derogation allowing for lower levels for national only operators. The Department for Transport has now concluded that under EU legislation the financial standing minimum should be the same for both national and international operators.

The Traffic Commissioners retain their discretion to set the financial standing levels for restricted licence holders. They propose to increase this amount in line with increases for standard international licence holders.

The revised figures are set out below and are based on the Euro exchange rate on 1 October. They will come into force on 1 January 2005 and will remain in place for five years. (Previously published rates are in brackets).

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Notes

1. The users of goods vehicles over 3.5 tonnes and public service vehicles must hold an operator's licence. The operator licensing system is administered by the statutorily independent Traffic Commissioners.
2. Licence holders must satisfy the Traffic Commissioner that they have available sufficient finances to safely maintain their vehicles and to properly administer the business. The required levels are set in Euros by EU Directive 96/26/EC, as amended by Directive 98/76/EC.
3. Non-Euro participating Member States are required to review the value of the Euro in their currencies every five years. The exchange rates to be applied are those on the first working day of October and come into

PSV Operator Licensing

Inspection of licence applications can be requested under the provisions of Regulation 4 of the Public Service Vehicles (Operators’ Licences) Regulations 1995 by anybody who holds statutory Objector status. Applications may be inspected free of charge at the Traffic Commissioner’s office by any person who carries written authorisation to act in that capacity. Alternatively, copies of weekly publications can be obtained by either an annual subscription of £91 or £3.50 for individual publications.

Objections against applications for licences may be made in writing by a Chief Officer of Police or local authority within 21 days after the date on which notice of an application is published in Notices and Proceedings. Objections must be made on the grounds that one or more of the requirements mentioned in Section 14(1) and (3) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 are not satisfied in relation to the application. A copy of the objection must be sent by the Objector to the applicant at the same time that it is sent to the Traffic Commissioner. The onus of proof in terms of the grounds on

which an objection is lodged lies with the objector. There is no right of objection against an application for a special licence submitted under Section 12 of the Transport Act 1985.

Classification of Operator Licences - There are four classes of licence: -

- A **Standard International (S/I)** licence authorises the use of any description of public service vehicle on both National and International operations;
- A **Standard National (S/N)** licence authorises the use of any description of public service vehicle on National operations;
- A **Restricted (R)** licence authorises the use of (a) public service vehicles not adapted to carry more than eight passengers and (b) those not adapted to carry more than sixteen passengers when used otherwise than in the course of a business of carrying passengers or by a person whose main occupation is not the operation of public service vehicles adapted to carry more than eight passengers;
- A **Special Restricted (SR)** licence under Section 12 of the Transport Act 1985 is granted to the holder of a taxi licence to enable local services to be operated.

Appeals in connection with PSV Operator Licences must be lodged with the Transport Tribunal, Procession House, 55 Ludgate Hill, London EC4M 7JW not later than 28 days after the date of the letter conveying the Traffic Commissioner's (or Deputy Traffic Commissioner's) decision. A copy of the appeals booklet is available from the Traffic Area Office on request.

Registration Of Local Bus Services

Please note the fee for each new application and variation application has been increased to £45 from the 1st November 2004. Applications to cancel registrations are free. Please also note that the fee for each new application and variation application for Community Bus Permits has been increased to £11 from the 1st November 2004.

A revised Guide and application forms (for registering a new service, changing or canceling an existing service have been available from this office since summer 2003. They are also available in Adobe acrobat format (pdf) to print and download from our website at www.vosa.gov.uk .

Left click on the "Forms" option from the menu on the right hand side of the screen.
Select "bus registrations" from the central menu.

The Guide (PSV 353A (Scotland)) contains much helpful advice with which anyone applying to operate, or anyone operating, a local bus services should be familiar.

To avoid delays to your application, this is what you must do:

Inform the relevant authorities (Local Authority/Strathclyde Passenger Transport) of your intentions 14 days before sending an application to the Traffic Commissioner,
Make sure you attach to the application the LA/SPT receipt or other information in confirmation that you informed them,
Give reasons, in the case of a request for the period of notice if it is less than 56 days, or a change or cancellation within 90 days of the start, or last change to a service,

and, in the case of changes and cancellations –

Give an undertaking that you will publicise service changes by displaying notices on buses for not less than 21 days before the change is due to come into effect.

It is up to you to provide this information so that all parties (operators, LA/SPT and the Traffic Commissioner) can improve information about bus services and encourage bus usage.

The new forms must be used.

We want to improve our service to the industry. Using out of date forms helps no one and creates delay, **so we will return, un-actioned, all applications received on obsolete forms after Friday 27 February 2004, and the applicants will be required to re-submit their applications using the current form(s).**

Some of the periods of notice applicable before the operation of registered services, including variations or cancellations, are at the discretion of the Traffic Commissioner. In such cases the application must be accompanied by a written explanation of why a short notice period is required along with, if appropriate, a letter from the local authorities/SPT indicating support. Please refer to Appendix 4 of the Guide for further information.
