CODE OF CONDUCT ON SERVICE STABILITY

FOREWORD

This Code of Conduct was produced for the Bus Partnership Forum and has been agreed by the member organisations (see below) with effect from 1 March 2003. It is commended to all operators and local authorities for early implementation in their areas by voluntary agreement. It is supported by Transport Ministers, the National Assembly for Wales and the Traffic Commissioners. The Office of Fair Trading is satisfied that it is compatible with the Competition Act 1998.

The aims of the code are:

- to reduce the number of days of the year on which network or timetable changes take place;
- to reduce the number of changes to an individual service
- to ensure that local authorities have sufficient notice of forthcoming commercial service changes so that they can complete the tendering process and issue publicity in sufficient time for the implementation of the service changes;
- to ensure that operators have sufficient notice of tenders and tender awards so that any consequential operational changes to other services can be implemented from the same date that the tenders come into effect.
- to allow operators and local authorities to reflect important changes in passenger demand, including education and employment needs, and the needs of operational reliability including Traffic Commissioners' performance standards.

The code will apply in England (outside London) and Wales. Its working will be reviewed after 12 months of operation.

CODE OF CONDUCT ON SERVICE STABILITY

1. INTRODUCTION

This document is based on one that has been in operation in Greater Manchester for over 4 years.

The overall objective is to increase customer confidence in bus service provision, thereby contributing to passenger growth. An individual bus customer should be able to rely on more stable bus services, experiencing fewer changes to his / her part of the network, and fewer changes to his / her service.

The aims of the Code are:

- to reduce the number of days of the year on which network or timetable changes take place;
- to reduce the number of changes to an individual service
- to ensure that local authorities have sufficient notice of forthcoming commercial service changes so that they can complete the tendering process and issue publicity in sufficient time for the implementation of the service changes;
- to ensure that operators have sufficient notice of tenders and tender awards so that any consequential operational changes to other services can be implemented from the same date that the tenders come into effect.
- to allow operators and local authorities to reflect important changes in passenger demand, including education and employment needs, and the needs of operational reliability including Traffic Commissioners' performance standards

It is proposed that these arrangements will be put into effect by means of a voluntary Code of Conduct, which will be adopted by CPT, PTEG, ATCO and the LGA. It will apply in England and Wales. A different regulatory framework applies in London.

2. COMMENCEMENT DATE

It is intended that this code of conduct commences on 1st March 2003. The process of change to the new procedure should be in place within 6 months.

3. SERVICE CHANGE DATES

The schedule below gives a list of service change dates which have been set out for the next five years. It will be seen that there are 12 dates per year. At present, operators are free to change services throughout the year, effectively on 52 dates. The aim is that operators and local authorities decide, for each area, which six dates should be adopted, and that these should be implemented within the next six months. This is a maximum target, and agreements on fewer dates should be encouraged where these can be achieved locally. The schedule covers the next 5 years to allow for tenders of up to 5 years in duration.

If an operator fails to comply with one of the service change dates, it is suggested that the local authority has no obligation to provide appropriate publicity for the changes until the next agreed service change date. In doing so, however, care must be taken to ensure that passengers are not put at a disadvantage by the lack of appropriate publicity about a service change. Alternatively, a local authority Information Strategy may specify that the information is provided, but the operator charged for such provision.

Note: there is an issue relating to future rail change dates, which may have to be amended to comply with an EC Directive.

With the exception of the first January date, the dates are mainly the Sunday before the last Monday in the month, which is the principle used for the national rail timetable change dates. In an increasingly integrated environment, the aim should be to change bus services, as far as possible, to coincide with rail service change dates. The rail change dates should therefore be two of the dates selected locally.

Clearly, if a service does not run on a Sunday the new timetable can still commence on a Sunday even though the first effective journeys will be on the Monday. Equally, some bus companies have rosters starting on a Saturday. In this case the first effective journeys will be on the Saturday. This should not affect the principle.

If the February service change date is chosen, operators and local authorities should take account of the Christmas / New Year holiday period, and allow extra time for the Traffic Commissioners to process registrations.

It is appreciated that services to and from schools or which are directly affected by either school services or the award of a school contract may commence at the start of the school term which may not always be the August service change date. However, local authorities should co-ordinate their Education contract dates with the agreed local bus service change dates. Similarly it is accepted that services for Universities need to start at University term start dates, and seasonal services may start and / or finish on a variety of dates in different areas.

In all such circumstances, the procedure and timings of registrations laid down in Appendix 1 should still be followed by all parties, with start and finish dates pre-notified separately where these 'dated services' do not coincide with the locally agreed change dates.

A list of these, and other possible exceptions, is set out in Appendix 2.

Within the above framework, it is suggested that:

- Up to six specific dates should be selected from the list and agreed locally between local authorities and operators.
- Operators should seek to avoid changing an individual service more than twice a year.
- For cross boundary services, a lead local authority should be agreed, based on the area where most of the service operates.

TENDERED SERVICES IN METROPOLITAN AREAS

In large Metropolitan areas, or large County areas, it is suggested that PTEs or local authorities may wish to work towards having set dates for tenders in different parts of the area. This reduces the number of tender change dates in a particular area to one a year, thereby improving service stability and spreading the workload associated with tender renewals.

For example, the process adopted within Greater Manchester has tender renewal dates spread as follows:

February date	Bury, Tameside and Wigan (west)
April date	Trafford, Oldham and Wigan (east)
June date	Manchester, Stockport and Bolton

August date

Works services, Rochdale and Salford

The termination dates of existing tenders will not necessarily coincide with the new system and discussions with operators should take place to find a mutually acceptable way of bringing dates into line.

NOTICE PERIODS AND INFORMATION REQUIRED

Commercial services

In order to complete the processes of:

- analysing proposed service changes to determine if there is a need for a local authority response;
 - the local authority response;
- production and distribution of all publicity at least 7 days in advance of the service changes

Authorities should have, confidentially,

- 11 weeks notice of proposed registration for timetable changes. These changes to include retimings, reduced or increased frequencies, or
- Where a change to the network is envisaged, operators should consult authorities on proposed changes more than 11 weeks in advance. These changes to include broken or revised network links, and withdrawals which will leave sections of road uncovered by services (either as a whole, or by time of day).
- Where appropriate, a statement that stand allocations in relevant bus stations have been agreed.

Authorities will treat all such information on a formal “Commercial in Confidence” basis until the 56-day registration period commences. Detailed timings of the processes to be followed, depending on response necessary, are set out in Appendix 1.

Customer uncertainty is sometimes increased unnecessarily at the time of service changes if a commercial deregistration is to be replaced in some way with a local authority tender. The additional consultation period set out above should give sufficient time for the bus operator and local authority to issue a joint statement making it clear that there is a possibility of a replacement facility.

Tendered Services

Local Authorities will give operators 15 weeks notice of forthcoming contracts for new services and / or tender renewals and will award contracts 11 weeks before the commencement date.

This should give operators time to register the contract service together with any consequential changes to other services.

Where certainty of funding permits, Local Authorities should award contracts for more than a one year duration, in order to reduce the number of registration changes which, if a tender simply changes hands, will not involve a service change.

Detailed timings of the process to be followed are set out in Appendix 1.

Appendix 1

1. Registration involving only a Timetable Change

11 weeks before	-	Operator consults on proposed service changes (public and LA)
8 weeks before	-	Operator provides registration and full timetable to LA
7 weeks before	-	LA confirm that no response will be necessary. Publicity process and PTI Call Centre data update commence
4 weeks before	-	LA provide data to PTI Call Centre (verified by operator)
At least 1 week before	-	Timetables distributed. Data goes live in PTI Call Centre
During the week before	-	Roadside publicity displayed

2. Registration involving Network Change

11 weeks <u>plus</u> before	-	Operator consults on proposed service changes (public and LA)
8 weeks before	-	Operator provides registration and full timetable to LA.
7 weeks before	-	LA issues implements procedures in response to commercial changes Publicity process and PTI Call Centre data update commence
5 weeks before	-	LA award contract
4 weeks before	-	LA provide data to PTI Call Centre (verified by operator) Operator submits registration with LA support
At least 1 week before	-	Timetables issued Data goes live in PTI Call Centre

- During the week before - Roadside publicity displayed
- Implementation date - All changes become effective

Note: where a local authority response to a registration change is initially by the issue of an emergency contract, that local authority needs to comply with Section 91(4) of the Transport Act 1985, which states that “any emergency contract shall remain in force no later than the end of the period of three months beginning with the day immediately following the end of the period allowed for the submission of tenders.” This means that the closing date for the submission of any substantive tender needs to be carefully timed to ensure that the implementation of that substantive tender can coincide with a service change date.

3. Contracts for New Services or Tender Renewals

- At least 15 weeks before - Contract issued
- 13 weeks before - Bids received
- 11 weeks before - Decision and contract award
- 8 weeks before - Operator submits Registration, with any consequential changes
- Then follows procedure in (1) above

Appendix 2

Possible Exceptions from Compliance With Fixed Change Dates

Operators and local authorities will seek to observe the Fixed Change Dates at all times but it is recognised that there will be exceptional circumstances which make this unachievable. The following situations have been identified.

1. Where an operator needs to make a commercial response to a competitive initiative by another operator.
2. Where an operator needs to modify a service to take account of changing road traffic conditions of either a temporary nature (e.g. for the duration of roadworks) or to reflect an indeterminate change (e.g. a worsening of traffic congestion and, hence, traffic speeds).
3. Where an operator or local authority needs to address a problem that has arisen which is having an adverse impact on particular customers.

Other, more exceptional circumstances, would include operator acquisitions and mergers, depot openings or closures, opening or closing of factories, shopping centres and leisure centres, and changes to legislation. Most of these should be capable of being resolved within the process, by the use of pre-notified change dates.

Section 2

PSV Operator Licensing

Inspection of licence applications can be requested under the provisions of Regulation 4 of the Public Service Vehicles (Operators' Licences) Regulations 1995 by anybody who holds statutory Objector status. Applications may be inspected free of charge at the Traffic Commissioner's office by any person who carries written authorisation to act in that capacity. Alternatively, copies of weekly publications can be obtained by either an annual subscription of £91 or £3.50 for individual publications. Details can also be viewed by visiting **the VOSA website at** www.vosa.gov.uk

Objections against applications for licences may be made in writing by a Chief Officer of Police or local authority within 21 days after the date on which notice of an application is published in Notices and Proceedings. Objections must be made on the grounds that one or more of the requirements mentioned in Section 14(1) and (3) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 are not satisfied in relation to the application. A copy of the objection must be sent by the Objector to the applicant at the same time that it is sent to the Traffic Commissioner. The onus of proof in terms of the grounds on which an objection is lodged lies with the objector. There is no right of objection against an application for a special licence submitted under Section 12 of the Transport Act 1985.

Classification of Operator Licences - There are four classes of licence: -

- A **Standard International (S/I)** licence authorises the use of any description of public service vehicle on both National and International operations;
- A **Standard National (S/N)** licence authorises the use of any description of public service vehicle on National operations;
- A **Restricted licence (R)** authorises the use of (a) public service vehicles not adapted to carry more than eight passengers and (b) those not adapted to carry more than sixteen passengers when used otherwise than in the course of a business of carrying passengers or by a person whose main occupation is not the operation of public service vehicles adapted to carry more than eight passengers;
- A **Special Restricted (SR)** licence under Section 12 of the Transport Act 1985 is granted to the holder of a taxi licence to enable local services to be operated.

Appeals in connection with PSV Operator Licences must be lodged with the Transport Tribunal, 48-49 Chancery Lane, London WC2A 1JR not later than 28 days after the date of the letter conveying the Traffic Commissioner's (or Deputy Traffic Commissioner's) decision. A copy of the appeals booklet is available from the Traffic Area Office on request.
