FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

I refer to your e-mail of 9th and my subsequent acknowledgement of 10th August 2006 concerning use of land as an Operating Centre by Owens (Road Services) Ltd at ex Whitehead Works, Mendalgief Road, Newport, South Wales.

The application to remove an operating centre from the O licence held by this operator in the Welsh Traffic Area (OG0079437) at Traston House, Corporation Road, Newport, and replace it with a new operating centre at ex Whitehead works was advertised in the South Wales Argus on 10th April 2006. The variation details were also published in the fortnightly publication of the Welsh Traffic Area, Applications and Decisions on 26th April 2006 (A&D No 8186), (url <http://www.vosa.gov.uk/vosa/publications/a&d%208186%20-%2026th%20april%202006.pdf>) and the grant of the variation on 24th May 2006 (A&D No 8188), (url <http://www.vosa.gov.uk/vosa/publications/a&d%208188%20-%2024th%20may%202006.pdf>) which allows 8 vehicles and 30 trailers to operate from this site.
