**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000**

I refer to your request for information dated 1<sup>st</sup> July 2008, which we have dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested information relating to mileage rates currently paid by the Vehicle and Operator Services Agency. The following tables give the details:-

**CARS**

<b><u>STANDARD RATE</u></b>	<b><u>Engine size up to 1500cc</u></b>	<b><u>Engine size over 1500cc</u></b>
0 – 6000 miles	49.5p per mile	58.5p per mile
Over 6000 miles	35.0p per mile	35.0p per mile

**MOTORCYCLES**

<b><u>STANDARD RATE</u></b>	<b><u>Up to 125cc</u></b>	<b><u>125 – 500cc</u></b>	<b><u>Over 500cc</u></b>
0 – 4000 miles	25.5p per mile	37.5p per mile	48.0p per mile
Over 4000 miles	11.0p per mile	14.5p per mile	17.5p per mile

**PUBLIC TRANSPORT RATE** (Cars and Motorcycles) – 35p per mile

**PEDAL CYCLES** – 21p per mile

**PASSENGER SUPPLEMENTS** – 5p per mile for each passenger carried

**EQUIPMENT SUPPLEMENT** – 4p per mile where equipment is carried inside the car.
