

Advice for presenters of diesel engine vehicles



As part of the MOT test you will be given a Diesel Smoke Test Information leaflet. Also, you may be asked questions about the vehicle's maintenance history, for example, has the timing belt been replaced recently?

It is important that you take the time to read the leaflet; if you don't understand any of its content please ask for further explanation.

Why is this information important?

The check has been developed to make sure, as far as possible, that no damage occurs to the engine whilst undergoing a diesel emissions test.

The tester has to satisfy him/herself as far as is practical, that the engine is in a fit condition to test. Any information you can give to the tester may be useful.

If you think your vehicle is not in a fit condition for this test please tell the tester.
