

**IM 9.1 LIGHTING/SIGNALING – Side Repeaters on Kit Cars - ISSUED 26/08/05**

Procedure and Standards item 2, note 7 provides for side repeaters on “Lotus Seven” styled vehicles to be acceptable in respect of angles of visibility providing they are clearly visible to other road users to the rear of the nearside and offside of the vehicle as appropriate.

It has been decided to extend this dispensation to all Amateur Built vehicles (class A) and Vehicles manufactured using parts of a registered vehicle (class C)

In P&S 2 please replace “Note 7” with the following text:-

**NOTE 7a:** Side Repeaters on an Amateur Built vehicle (class A) or Vehicle manufactured using parts of a registered vehicle (class C) will be considered to meet the angles of visibility requirements providing the lamps are clearly visible to the rear of the nearside and offside of the vehicle as appropriate. (See Annex 8)

**NOTE 7b:** A Side Repeater indicator mounted on a “cycle wing” that moves with steering movement, must meet the requirements with the steering in the straight ahead position only.
