

**BRAKES (Hydraulic and Vacuum Systems) – Antilock Function Check – Issued 29/06/04.**

Procedure and Standards item 4,e,i, requires a visual check that the ABS system is functional, stating “eg a component missing, damaged, insecure or disconnected such that the system is unlikely to function as intended.”

As a visual examination does not, in all cases identify a malfunction, unless the warning light illuminates during the speedometer test indicating correct function, item 4,e,i, must be checked by driving the vehicle and carrying out a dynamic brake test to check system operation.

Please add the following note after item e,i.

NOTE : Where ABS operation is in doubt a dynamic brake test must be conducted to check system function.

Please amend Reason for Failure e, item “i” to read:-

- i.
  - component missing, damaged, insecure, or disconnected such that the system is unlikely to function as intended, or
  - inoperative.
