<b>Details Of Enquiry:</b>  Many motorcycles imported from the U.S. have hard wired headlamps (always on) do these motorcycles also need a front position lamp or can the headlamp perform both duties.	
<b>Answer:</b>  Front position lamps are obligatory for all categories of vehicle tested other than two – wheeled mopeds. This requirement applies to vehicles whether or not they have “hard wired headlamps” also known as Automatic Headlamps On (AHO). This situation has arisen because the European requirements are based on having switched lights but do not disallow hard wired systems but retains all of the requirements.
