

## Notification of Failure to comply with the Conditions of Acceptance of a Goods Vehicle for Examination



Vehicle & Operator Services Agency

Regulation 7 & 8 of the Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) Regulations 1988 (as amended)

The goods vehicle with registration number/chassis serial number/trailer identification mark:-

having been submitted for an examination under Sections 49 & 51 of The Road Traffic Act 1988. It is hereby notified that the examination did not proceed because of failure to comply with those conditions of acceptance for examination set out below which are indicated by a tick.

1. The vehicle was not submitted for test at the appointed time. [ ]
2. The relevant test fee has not been paid. [ ]
3. The trailer was not accompanied by a suitable motor vehicle. [ ]
4. There is not permanently fixed to the vehicle ,the chassis/serial number as shown on the registration document (motor vehicle) or the identification mark issued by the Secretary of State (trailer). [ ]
5. A Ministry Plate is not fitted to the vehicle. [ ]
6. The particulars of the vehicle or trailer (e.g. number of axles / axle weights) do not match the VTG 6 "Ministry Plate" fitted to the vehicle. [ ]
7. The vehicle or motor vehicle by which it was accompanied, emits substantial quantities of exhaust smoke so as to make it unreasonable for the test to be carried out. [ ]
8. The vehicle and/or trailer (any part) was in such a dirty\* or dangerous condition as to make it unreasonable for the test to be carried out. [ ]
9. No proof was given that the vehicle used for carrying dangerous/toxic/corrosive or inflammable loads had been cleared or otherwise rendered safe for test. [ ]
10. The vehicle did not have sufficient fuel and oil to allow the test to be carried out. [ ]
11. The vehicle was not loaded as required. [ ]
12. The test could not be completed due to failure of a part of the vehicle, or trailer and accompanying motor Vehicle which made movement under its own power, or under the power of the accompanying motor vehicle impossible. [ ]
13. The vehicle or trailer is presented for test carrying livestock, or other unsuitable material. [ ]
14. Current Health and Safety legislation cannot be met in testing the vehicle or trailer. [ ]
15. The vehicle exhaust outlet has been modified in such a way to prevent a metered smoke check being conducted.[ ]
16. The examiner could not open the tachograph. [ ]
17. The driver and/or presenter of the vehicle refused to or was unable to comply with the instructions of VOSA staff, such that it is impractical and/or unsafe to continue the vehicle examination. [ ]

**NB.\*Definition of 'dirty' – "A component in a condition whereby it cannot be thoroughly inspected".**
