



Opportunity - for developers of hand held devices

Computerisation of MOT testing in Vehicle Testing Stations (VTS) has now been successfully operational for some time. As part of an ongoing strategy to provide additional efficiency features for users, a data communications interface is being developed to permit the exchange of data with the computer in the VTS. This will enable vehicle testers to capture information on devices such as hand held PDAs or palm tops. The interface will also enable approved third party devices to connect and interact with the VTS computer.

Vehicle and Operator Services Agency (VOSA) will be holding an open forum on **15 March 2007** at VOSA HQ in Bristol, for prospective developers of products using the interface. The forum will provide information on what needs to be done in both organisational and technical terms.
